

## Five Inch Charms – a scrap fabric quilt design by Mary Hogan



Each block has a finished size of 9 inches and uses /medium and dark charm squares (5 inch squares). Using 63 four patch blocks (7 wide, 9 long) the finished top is 63 in. by 81 in. without borders.

**Cutting Instructions:** For each four patch block you will need:

A: 2 - 5 x 5 in.; 4.5 X 4.5 in. finished (total for all blocks – 126) light colored squares

B: 2 - 5 x 5 in.; 4.5 X 4.5 in. finished (total for all blocks – 126) dark or medium colored squares

Or make this completely scrappy with randomly placed color and value. Need 156 five inch squares

**Block Instructions:** this block is made in two sections (note the dashed line) and then sewn together.

For each block:

Sew each A unit to each of the B units as shown to get 2 A/B units

Sew the two A/B units together to complete the block.

After making all 63 blocks, arrange 9 rows of 7 blocks keeping the pattern of light/mediums and dark fabrics within the blocks.
